Other accomplishments of Miller include being the former CEO of Communicating Arts CU, Director of Electronic Services for the Michigan Credit Union League, Founder and CEO of the first CU owned/shared ATM network, Founder and Chairman of CU Partner Solutions, Chairman of Affinity Group Services CUSO, Vice President of the Pontiac Police and Fire Pension Board, Vice Chairman of Oakland County Chapter of CU's and a former US Marine who proudly served this country in Viet Nam.
