

# Project Team Communication and Coordination Services

#### Do you need a Cross-Team Project Communicator?

Ask yourself the following six questions to determine if your project needs a Cross-Team Project Communicator.

1. Does the project involve multiple departments?

What I will do for you: I will use my extensive relationships with people at CU\*Answers and across the cuasterisk.com network to bring visibility and collaboration for the implementation of your project.

2. Do you need summaries to keep management and team members updated on the project meetings? Do you want these organized into a communication plan? (Do stakeholders want to hear about the project?)

What I will do for you: I will write communications about your project meetings and email them to groups that include upper management. I will also include them in a summary document.

3. Does this project require the creation of a team to work on the project, at minimum to send the communications?

What I will do for you: I will build an attendee list for meetings and for sending the communications covered in #2.

4. Does this project meet on a regular basis, for example weekly?

What I will do for you: I will schedule your project meetings as needed. I will lead or attend your project meetings, depending on our arrangement.

5. Does this project require a project plan and/or timeline with goals to be met?

What I will do for you: I will (if requested) build a project plan. Otherwise I will work with you to develop goals to be met. I will review your project goals at meetings. This will ensure we meet our deadlines.

6. Does this project involve a rollout to members? What about staff?

What I will do for you: I will assist with the rollout to staff or members.



## What is included?

I will provide the services agreed to that are listed on the previous page.

As the Project Leader you will remain the decision maker of the project. If I see the need for a decision to be made that is outside my role, I will engage you to make the final decision.

I will encourage team members to meet their deadlines in a friendly way and will notify you when we are not meeting the goals. As needed I will increase the team size by inviting new members. These changes will be reviewed by you. If I build your project plan, I will meet with individual team members, so everyone is aware of their responsibilities in the project.

I am available to work on a project during normal work days, between 8 AM and 5 PM ET. Special arrangements will be needed if coordination tasks are needed during non-working hours (weekends, evenings, etc.).

## Do you want to meet remotely?

Do you have people at multiple locations that will work on your project? Not a problem! I have worked on projects using Zoom, and they have been very effective.

## What is the pricing?

Below is the pricing per project.

- Per year contract: \$5,000.00\*
- Per six-month contract: \$3,000.00\*
- Per four-month contract: \$2,400.00\*

\*Project creep? Not a problem. Additional months are billed at the original monthly rate. For example, an additional month added to a six-month contract is \$500.00.
