## A New Platform for CU\*BASE


- Working with Rocket Software (makers of LegaSuite) to put CU\*BASE in a browser window
- ▶ Converting 18,000 panels
  - About half are custom
- ▶ Basic one-to-one conversion
  - Bells and whistles coming in future evolutions
- Targeting fall 2024!

- Planning for an eventual sunset of our current LegaSuite platform




