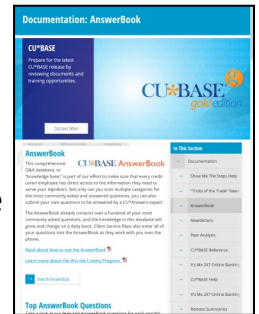
May Top Picks: Answer Book and More

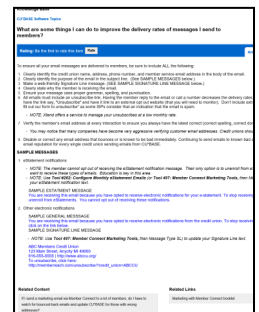
Pick #3: Which Answer Book item from the "Top Answer Book" monthly email received the most views?

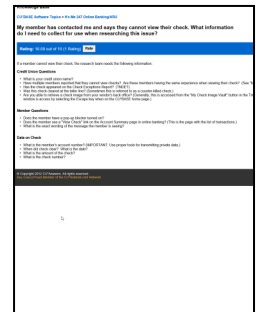
Pick #4: What are some things I can do to improve the delivery rates of messages I send to members?
