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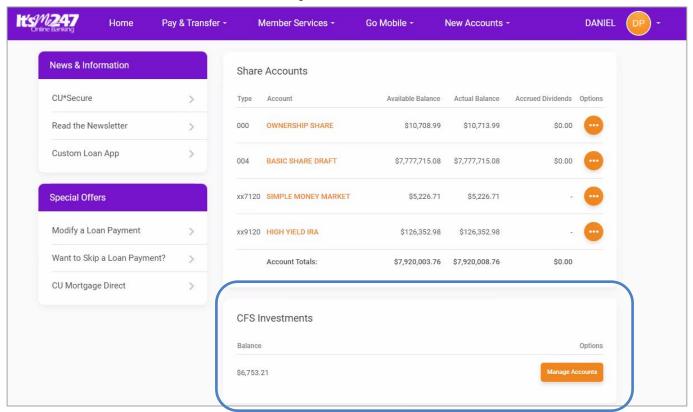
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VIEWING INVESTMENTS ONLINE

As an introduction to this booklet, we think it is helpful to begin with what the member sees once you have begun offering access to investments to them through CFS.

Once authenticated in **It's Me 247**, the **It's Me 247** Investment Center displays member's investment accounts right alongside their credit union accounts. (As you can see the Investments section is shown below the sections for other accounts.)

From here, the member clicks "Manage Accounts" to access the CFS website were they can view their investments.

DAY-BY-DAY PROCESSING

This applies for the CU*BASE side of this document.

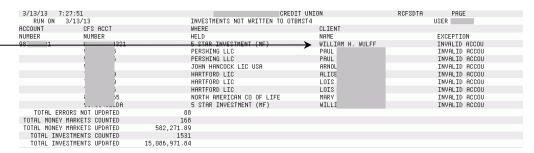
Each day the "Investments Not Written to OTBMST" report (shown below) is saved to your credit union's Daily OUTQ. (Use speed sequence OUTQD for easy access to this OUTQ.)

This report lists members who have initiated opening an account with CFS, but who have either entered an invalid CU*BASE account when enrolling for their CFS account (or otherwise have an invalid account associated with this account).

• The first entry on this report will always be William H Wulff. This is a phony member and does not need to be worked.

Entries other than the William H Wulff entry will need to be worked. Contact CFS to update the members account. CFS can be contacted at 1-877-287-6638.

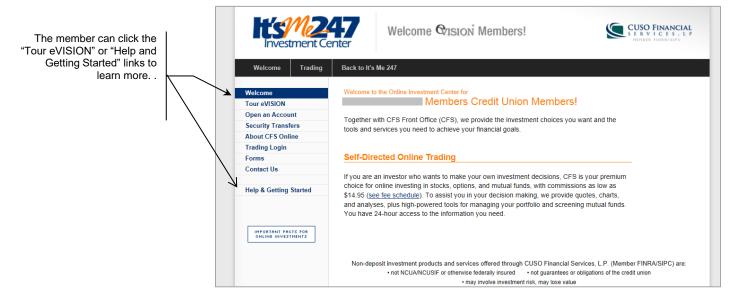
The first entry "William H. Wulff is a phony entry and does not need to be worked.



At the bottom of the report you can view the total number and dollar amount of money markets and investments that are updated.

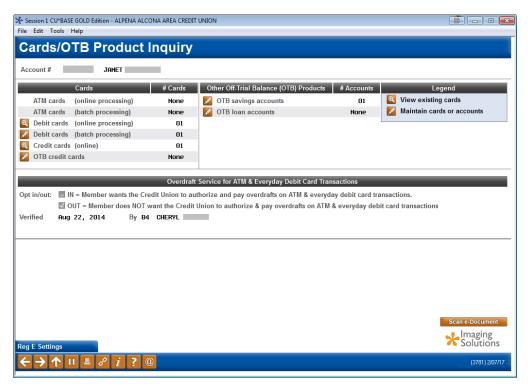
HOW MEMBERS ENROLL ONLINE

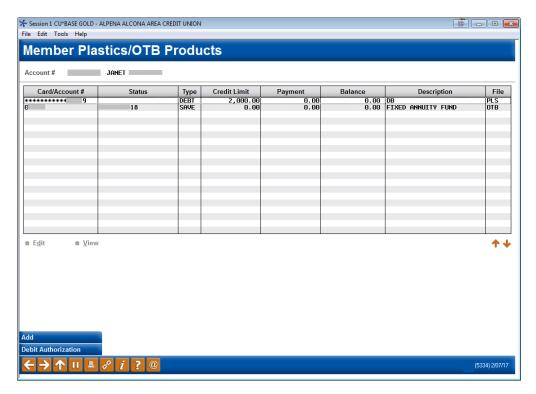


CU*BASE SIDE OF INVESTMENTS

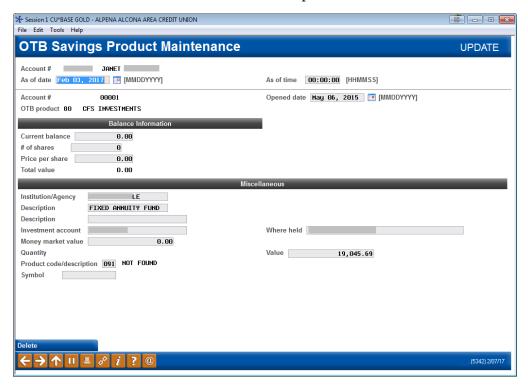
To view the investments of a member in CU*BASE, use Phone Operator or Inquiry and then OTB Accounts (F17). This will take you to the OTB Inquiry screen shown below.



From here, select the lookup next to "OTB savings accounts" in the right column. This will take you to a listing of all investments and other OTB accounts.



Selecting an individual investment will show the screen shown below. The information on this screen is as of the last update from CFS.



QUERYING INVESTMENT INFORMATION USING REPORT BUILDER

Use Report Builder and Query the OTBMST4 file for all OTB savings accounts. This will include investments and any other OTB savings accounts you offer to members.
