Fixes

- Adjusted the CU*Answers feature feed banners to automatically adjust the text if it would have otherwise run off the banner
- Adjusted the trends graph so that it does not force a complete reload of the graph whenever a user checks or unchecks the option to display the trend or average line
- Corrected a bug where a user could log in to the site even if their account had been disabled
- Corrected a bug where a user could log in to either the DEV or PRD environment and their session would bleed through to the other environment

Updates

- Adjusted styling of the trends popup window for a better visibility and usability
- Added "Getting Started" information to the new account email templates
- Added a feature to allow users to select which branches are included in the "Everything Alert"
- Enhanced the trends graph to allow users to view the data line, trend line, and average lines individually or any combination of the three
- Updated Site Management>Usage Stats>Users with the most custom alerts so that it displays additional information
- Enabled editing of the users first and last names, and email addresses. Users can edit their own information via My Account, credit union administrators can now edit a member's information via Member Management (only if that user does not belong to another credit union). Any CSR or higher can edit any member of equal or lesser access level via Member Management
- Added CSR Management page which allows "CU*Answers Admin" or higher accounts to add or edit CSR accounts
- Added a "Purge Account" functionality that allows a site administrator to completely remove an account that has been disabled in the system

Backend

- Created a virtual DEV environment using Vagrant and Chef to configure an Ubuntu 12.04 VM in VirtualBox, suitable for the development and testing of My CU Today

- Updated the CSV import process to run credit union maintenance after every import in order to ensure that any credit union name changes are applied to the site
- Updated the send alerts process so that it does not attempt to send an alert or "Nothing to report" email if it has already sent that alert on that day
