

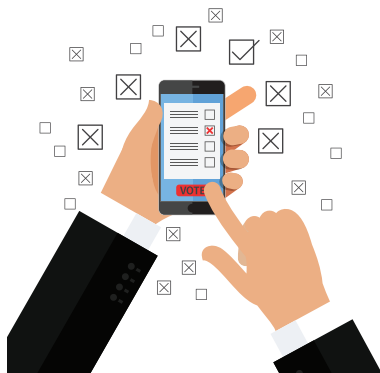
# Owner's VOICE

The next big idea is out there and Owner's Voice is the vehicle to grow, prioritize, bring value, and complete these projects.

# RULES OF THE GAME

## GENERAL RULES

1. To be an eligible user for Owner's Voice, you need to be a part of the credit union industry.
2. Every person that wants to vote or discuss CU\*BASE projects must have a user account on Owner's Voice.
3. Users cannot create their own forums or topics.
4. Projects are first categorized by where they are in their lifecycle stage:
  - Help Us Decide What's Next: Projects that have not been started.
  - Help Us Decide What to Focus On: Projects we are currently working on.
  - Help Us Decide What's on the Chopping Block: Projects we were once working on; however, progress has been paused.
5. For each lifecycle stage, projects are separated by their category:
  - Program Modifications: These projects are in line with past and ongoing investments that continue to serve the will and expectations of CU\*Answers' user base.
  - Software Enhancements: These are clear, new designs, to do what the software is not currently doing as a tool.
6. Lastly, there is a forum for discussion and a forum for voting in each of the those six categories.

## VOTING RULES

1. Voting topics are categorized by month, then year.
2. Voting for the current month will begin by the sixth of the month.
3. Users can select up to 10% of the projects listed when voting.
4. Users can only submit one vote per project they select.
5. Votes must be submitted by the end of the month.
6. Voting closes on the first of the following month.
7. Users are allowed to modify their votes before the month is over.
8. Users cannot discuss inside of the voting topics.
9. Users cannot create new topics in the voting forums.

## DISCUSSION RULES

1. Each month, new topics are created.
2. A new topic is created for each project.
3. Users cannot create new topics.
4. Topics include the project number, description, type, and hours worked (as of the time it was added).
5. Users can engage in discussion to ask questions or argue for or against a project by replying to a topic.
6. If you would like clarification on a projects description, do not hesitate to ask in the topic thread by replying to the topic.

## VOTING RESULTS

1. Monthly Reports are created to report the voting results of the previous month.
2. Monthly Reports are uploaded under the Owner's Voice Voting Results forum.
3. They are organized by month, then year. Just like voting.
4. Each Report contains all six categories of voting for the given month.
5. Each Report will only display the Top 40 from each of the six categories.
6. Once the Monthly Voting Results Report is created by the Owner's Voice Team, a copy will be given to CU\*Answers EVP of Development, Brian Maurer. The report will be present in CU\*Answers Production Meetings.
7. A more detailed explanation of the results is located on the second page of the report.

## PROJECTS MOVED TO PRODUCTION

1. By the 6th of the month, each project that has been put into production during the previous month will be moved to the "Moved To Production" forum under the Results section.
2. These projects are no longer eligible for votes since they are now in CU\*BASE.

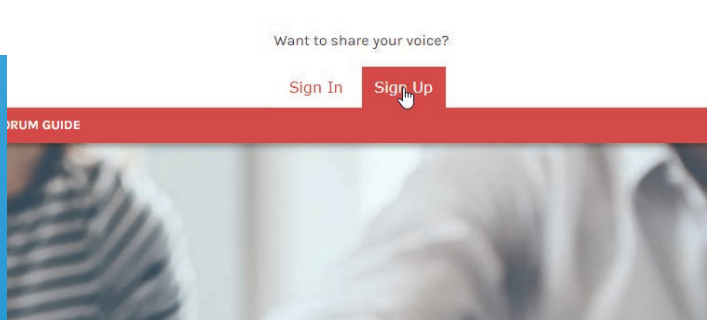
# HOW TO SIGN UP

## THE SIGN UP PROCESS

Participation on the Owner's Voice website requires users to sign up before joining the discussion or voting. Eligible users need to be a part of the credit union industry.

## 1 STARTING THE SIGN UP PROCESS

To begin the sign up process, visit [ownersvoice.cuanswers.com](https://ownersvoice.cuanswers.com) and click the Sign Up button in the top right corner of the web page. NOTE: Returning users enter the discussion and vote by clicking "Sign In."



## 2 TERMS OF SERVICE

# HOW TO VOTE

## USER VOTING

Inside of a project's voting topic, users are only able to cast or recast a vote. Discussion of voting topics is not permitted within the voting section.

NOTE: Additional topics can not be created within the voting area.

## 1 NAVIGATING TO A PROJECT CATEGORY

To begin voting, choose from the lifecycle stages "Help Us Decide What To Do Next," "Help Us Decide What To Stay Focused On," or "Help Us Decide What's On The Chopping Block," and then click on the category "Software Enhancements" or "Program Modifications."

## USER DISCUSSION

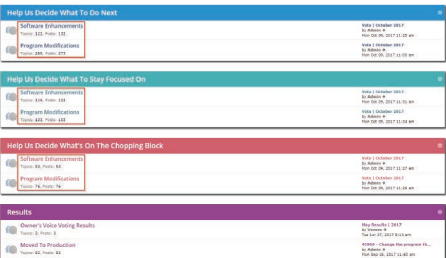
Discussion is a critical component of Owner’s Voice and users are encouraged to participate in all discussion topics presented on the website.

Note: New topics cannot be created.

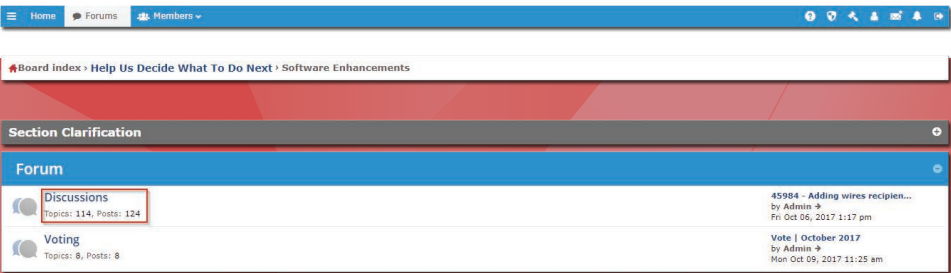
## 1 NAVIGATING TO A PROJECT CATEGORY

To start discussing a project, navigate to one of the six project categories.



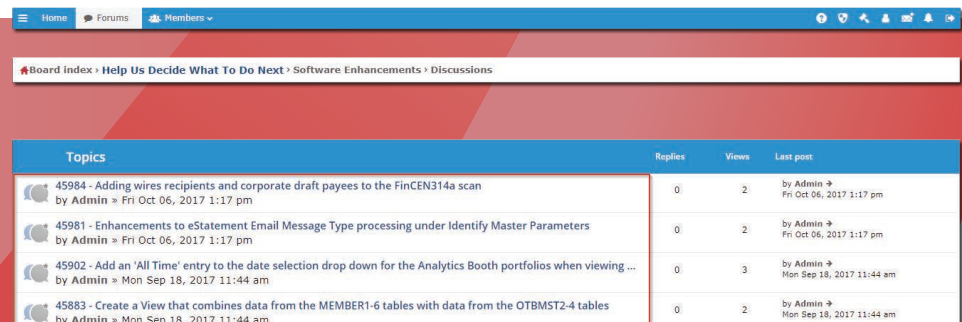
## 2 NAVIGATING TO THE DISCUSSION FORUM

Once a project category has been chosen, enter the discussion forum by clicking “Discussions.”



## 3 NAVIGATING TO A PROJECT TOPIC

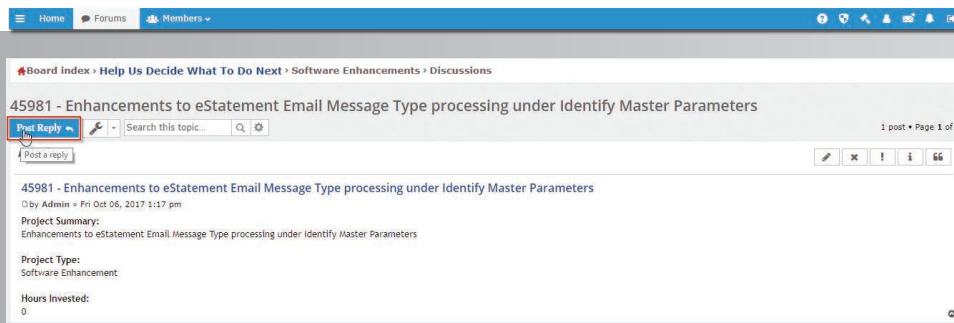
Once you’ve navigated to the Discussion Forum, decide which project you’d like to comment on. Each row is a different project.





## 4 STARTING A REPLY

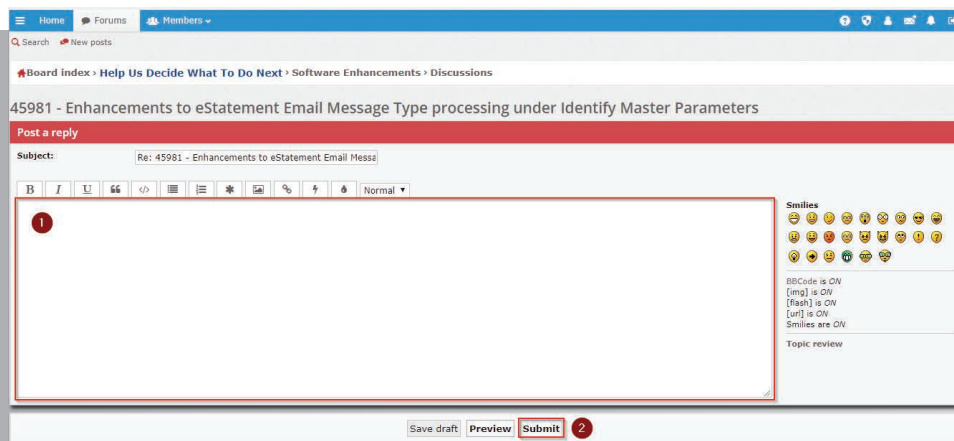
Select the “Post Reply” button to start your post and share an opinion, ask a question, etc.



## 5 CRAFTING A REPLY

Replies are entered by filling in the text box. The interface allows for text editing similar to Microsoft Word or advanced editing can be done with HTML and previewed by clicking “Preview” below the text box. Completed replies are submitted by clicking “Submit” below the text box.

NOTE: Replies can be saved as a draft and revisited by clicking “Save draft.”



## 6 STARTING A REPLY TO ANOTHER COMMENT

Replying to another user’s comment can be done by clicking the quote button on the corresponding reply.



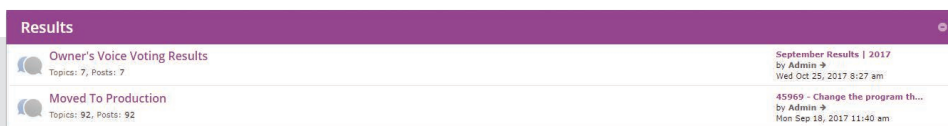
# HOW TO VIEW RESULTS

Click “Owner’s Voice Voting Results” at the bottom of the home page of the forum to visit the Results Forum.




### 2 NAVIGATE TO DESIRED YEAR

Click the month to view the results.


