New Look & Feel

The new user interface of PIB implements new views for viewing and editing your security preferences in a simplified and modern way.



CU Brandable

Similar to the customization being implemented in It's My Biz 247 Mobile, Credit Unions will have the opportunity to customize their member's PIB colors and logos.



Backwards Compatibility with PIB 1.0

With the possible implementation of a new URL, PIB 2.0 can be seamlessly implemented credit unions while keeping PIB 1.0 active for credit unions waiting to adopt.



Works on Mobile & Tablet

PIB 2.0 is mobile friendly, and can be accessed on any mobile or tablet web browser to make security changes for their online banking.

Apply PIB to Mobile Web and Apps


In Phase II of 2.0, the same security settings used to protect desktop versions of It's Me 247 could apply to mobile web and mobile apps as well.

Set restrictions so your account can only be accessed in our country, state, or city.




Transfer & Deposit Settings

Only allow your accounts to be accessed at certain times or days of the week.




Require Device Registration


Let your accounts be accessed on computers you trust.

Dashboard

Current PIB Users have no way of seeing what security settings they have activated without starting a brand new security setting. The new dashboard would allow users to quick reference what security they have in place, and give them quick links to edit them.

Any security settings pre-existing PIB users have in place will automatically populate in this new interface when a member logs in.












Custom Branding

Similar to It's My Biz 247 Mobile, the new PIB interface will be built on a customizable design system. With this, the Credit Union will be able to configure their member's PIB profiles to match the Credit Union's brand.




Streamlined Security Editing

Making Security Edits to Your Account

Starting a New Edit

When a member creates a new profile in PIB, they will have no security features activated. On their new dashboard, a progress bar will guide them in creating a Confirmation Code and link to a guide describing how to customize and activate their settings.


To start a new edit, a member can either click on the "Edit Settings" expandable menu, or on any of the gear icons in the section headers.



Editing a Setting


All security settings in PIB have been reorganized and grouped into eight categories, helping members locate their preferred security features when editing.

Upon adjusting a setting under one of the settings categories, a "Save" button at the bottom of the screen will appear in a fixed footed. When the member is finished editing, they must click the save button, returning them to the dashboard.




Activation Code

Upon returning to the dashboard after editing a setting, the desired new settings will be in a temporary state. A dialog will prompt members to click "Finish Editing" when all preferences have been adjusted, sending a confirmation code to the member's email address. The member will then enter the code in the same window, activating the new settings.




Activating New Settings

Once a valid activation code is entered, the desired settings are made active and appear as active in the dashboard.




Confirmation Code

Currently, a member's confirmation code can only be edited in the middle of a new security setting setup. Since this is often used as a secondary password for multiple types of transactions, it has been pulled to the main navigation level for easier access.



Confirmation Code (cont.)

If a member enables a transaction type to require a confirmation code, but has not yet created a code, they will be prompted to do so in an alert window before being able to send an activation code. Once the code has been created, it must be activated alongside any other new settings the member has enabled.







Mobile Web and Mobile App Capabilities

The new PIB Dashboard will also be available on mobile web browsers, maintaining it's clean and simple UI.










Edit Settings on Mobile

Members will also be able to view and edit their PIB settings on mobile devices. Like to the desktop, the member will edit a setting, tap "Save" (now located in a fixed footer bar), and be taken to the PIB Dashboard for activation.










Activate on Mobile

Once returned to the dashboard, the member will be prompted to enter their activation code (identical to desktop).










Mobile Apps
