What to Expect

Technology

If you are attending the Report Builder (Query) session please be sure to confirm and test ahead of time that you have a laptop available to bring, and that it is capable of remotely connecting to CU*BASE (VPN to your CU's home network).

Access to CU*BASE is important for the hands-on workshop sections of these sessions. A portable mouse is also suggested, but not required.

Travel

When making your travel plans to and from Grand Rapids, Michigan, please plan on arriving by the morning start-time of your first session. Please plan your departures for after the end-time listed on your last session. Review the agenda/schedule for exact times of each session.

Hotel

There are several hotels near our office location and many choices throughout the Grand Rapids area. We have corporate rates at the DoubleTree by Hilton and The Drury Inn - For those you will need to call and ask for the CU*Answers Corporate rate and it is not a room block.

Analytics Booth

A subscription to Analytics Booth is not required but if your credit union does have a subscription we recommend testing your login credentials. Visit www.analyticsbooth.com in the Chrome web browser to test your credentials. Your username is typically your credit union email address and the software provides a “Forgot Password” process to reset your password if needed.

Report Builder Skills Session

These are the tools we will cover and we recommend you have access to each. The ones absolutely required are Tool 100 and 332:

- 100 – Report Builder (Query)
- 332 – Database Search Assistant
- 1980 – Library Dashboard
- 1375 – Data Transfers (Uploads and Downloads)

- Tool 1375 is not required, but recommended if you are an approved person to download data from CU*BASE. This tool will only work if you ALSO have special download authority permissions. If you do not have those, the decision is up to your Security Officer and you may need to route file downloads to an authorized person instead.

- 654 – Print List of Custom Reports/Inquiries
- 758 – Report Automation – Custom Reports/Files
